#### **From Poverty to Power. How active citizens and effective states can change the world.**

The 21st century will be defined by the fight against the scourges of poverty, inequality, and the threat of environmental collapse. Green argues that it requires a radical redistribution of power, opportunities, and assets to break the cycle of poverty and inequality and to give poor people power over their own destinies. The forces driving this transformation are active citizens and effective states, participation is the instrument.

Bringing together for the first time classic and contemporary writings from a literature that spans a century, 'The Participation Reader' offers a perspective on the possibilities and dilemmas that face those seeking to empower people affected by development projects, programmes and policies.

Global Civil Society Yearbooks provide an guide to global civil society or civic participation and action around the world. The 2009 Yearbook explores the framings, strategies and impacts of a range of actors on poverty and its alleviation. The overarching question is to whether such actors in pressing for poverty alleviation actually achieve anything/empower the poor, or simply aid wealthy states in maintaining the status quo. The contributors are diverse, including scholars and practitioners from India, America, the UK, Australia, Thailand and Mali.

#### **Capacity-Building. An Approach to People-Centered Development.**

Capacity-building is an integral part of development theory and practice. However, aid agencies that ignore people's existing strengths may create dependency, and so make people more vulnerable than before. This book considers specific and practical ways in which NGOs can contribute it enabling people to build on capacities they already possess. It reviews the types of social organisation with which NGOs might consider working and the provision of training in a variety of relevant skills and activities. The particular importance of using a capacity-building approach in emergency situations, and of the dynamic and long-term nature of the process.

Based on a long term study, the book draws together the perspectives of a group of European NGOs and compares these with the experiences of a selection of their partners in Brazil, Cambodia and Tanzania.
